Final Drop Out Date: August 24

Drop outs after this date will be charged the remainder of their semester fees.

**** Total Tuition = (Base Tuition + ALL Additional Payments) / 4 payments**

Sibling discount: 10% off total family tuition.

OUR PAYMENT PLAN:

Tuition will be automatically broken into 4 equal payments.

Full tuition can be paid upfront, if desired, by August 30.

If you do not choose to pay full tuition upfront, we will need an updated card on file at all times. We will handle processing these payments for you.

So please expect for your card to be automatically drafted on the following dates:

1. August 13th
2. September 17th
3. October 15th
4. November 19th

*Please expect a transaction fee of \$2.90.

**If your card declines, please expect an immediate \$10 charge. Every 10 days that the payment continues to decline, another \$10 charge will be added to your account. After 30 days, your dancer will be immediately dropped from her classes with no refund.

Full Season Payment:

An option for you to pay for the entire season at once. This is only accepted with cash or check and will not include a discount. This is non-refundable.

Due: August 24, 2026

Cards on File Expectations:

All PGD Families must have an updated credit card on record with Jackrabbit. PGD reserves the right to process payments for tuition that is past due for a student actively attending classes.

Refunds:

There are NO refunds for paid fees.

Performance fees are not refundable. If the entire performance fee has been paid and a dancer needs to drop before the show then she will receive her costume. Once this season is completed, costumes that are not picked up will be donated to the studio's costume closet.

Performance Details:

“The Story”: TBD at Brenau’s Hosch Theatre.

1. Every class at PGD besides Pre-Pointe, Mommy and Me, and Acro are included in our performances. You will be receiving a student performance contract the first month of class. This is to be turned in by drop out date (August 24, 2026). This ensures that she is joining us onstage, will pay her performance fees on time, and will follow through to the end of the season (December 2026).
2. By enrolling with PGD, we expect your dancer to follow through with the above. If you do not wish to perform in our show with us, the front office needs to be notified upon enrollment. She will then be left out of choreography time in classes and will not receive a costume unless you choose to pay the performance fee.
3. Performance fees are \$90 per class. Every additional class is an additional \$80 to your dancer’s total. **Our office will be sending online invoices for performance fees, which you will process on your own.** There will be a \$5 service charge added. If you drop after turning in your signed performance agreement, your Jackrabbit account will be charged the entire/remaining performance fee.
1st payment: September 1 **2nd Payment: October 1**
4. You receive her costume during Costume Check Out Week.
5. ALL DETAILS are released in our Parent Meeting over Zoom. Check out our attached calendar to see when the Parent Meeting will be held in October. Your teachers and directors will not be able to release any information regarding the show before that date.
6. If you wish to guarantee that all of your dancer’s classes are featured in the same show, we advise to enroll her into classes which are scheduled on the same day and in the same category: Ex all beginning classes with Level 1 & 2.
7. Suggested Show Items to expect: PGD tights, flesh leotard, Red Scarlett Mary Kay Lipstick, garment bag (for those taking multiple classes), and ballet shoes in good condition. *This list always expands in details and we are here to help make sure she is prepared and ready for the stage! Do not stress now, we just want you to know what to expect.
9. Other Show Expenses: Tickets, Show Pictures, Show Videos, Show Gifts, Ornaments, Flowers. (Everything but tickets are optional add ons)
